Applications in prescribed format are invited from the citizens of India belonging to the Garo Community for filling up 2 (two) posts of Judicial Magistrate, Subordinate District Council Court, Garo Hills Autonomous District Council, Tura, in the level of pay Rs. 77,840-1,36,520/- PM plus other allowances as admissible under the relevant rules of the Garo Hills Autonomous District (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1953, as per the following terms and conditions: -

1. ELIGIBILITY: -

The candidate shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment for the post of Judicial Magistrate, Subordinate District Council Court Garo Hills Autonomous District Council Court, on fulfilling the following criteria: -

- (i) Must be a permanent resident of Meghalaya.
- (ii) Must be holder of degree in law of a recognized university.
- (iii) Must be practicing as an Advocate in Courts of criminal and civil jurisdiction at the time of submission of application and must have been practicing for a period of not less than 3 (three) years. A certificate to this effect from the concerned Bar Association must be enclosed.
- (iv) Must have attained the age of 27 (twenty-seven) years and must not have attained the age of 37 (thirty-seven) years as on the last date fixed for receipt of the applications.
- (v) Must be conversant in Garo customs and practices, Garo language and usage prevalent in the Autonomous Districts of Garo Hills.

2. APPLICATION PROCESS: -

- (1) The application must be submitted in the prescribed format on payment of Rs.100/- only, from the Receipt Cell of this District Council.
- (2) Application must be accompanied by the following documents: -
 - (i) An application fee of Rs. 500 (Rupees Five Hundred) only be paid through Council Treasury Challan.
 - (ii) Three copies of recent passport size photograph.
 - (iii) Schedule Tribe Certificate (attested copy).
 - (iv) Birth Certificate/ School Certificate indicating the date of birth (attested Copy)
 - (v) L.L.B. Certificate and L.L.B. Mark Sheets from any recognized University (attested Copy)

- (vi) Other Certificates of academic achievement (if any) (attested copy)
- (vii) State/District Bar Council Enrolment Certificate (attested copy).

(3) (i) the Application along with all supporting documents complete in all respect must be submitted in a sealed envelope to the Member Secretary, Selection Committee, Garo Hills Autonomous District Council, Tura.

(ii) The sealed envelope must be captioned/superscribed in bold letters as "Application for the Post of Judicial Magistrate, Subordinate District Council Court and must reach the Member Secretary, Selection Committee, Garo Hills Autonomous District Council, Tura on or before the 20th of July, 2026 during office hours.

(4) Any wrong or incorrect information furnished by the candidate shall lead to rejection of his/her candidature at any stage. Candidates using unfair/illegal means during the conduct of the recruitment process will be de-barred from appearing the examination.

(5) Date of Written Examination for eligible candidates will be notified in due course.

3. Method of selection: -

Written Examination

Written Examination will be conducted for the post of Judicial Magistrate, Subordinate District Council Court, Garo Hills Autonomous District Council, Tura, in 3 (Three) paper of 100 marks each as specified below: -

Paper-I: One paper of 150 marks (duration 3 hours) containing two parts: -

Part-I (100 marks) —

1. General Knowledge, General Aptitude, Comprehension and Expression of Law.
2. General English including Essay Writing on legal topic.

Part –II (50 marks) –

1. Garo customs, Garo language and usages prevalent in the Autonomous District.

Paper II: - One paper of 100 marks (duration 3 hours) —

1. Constitutional Law including the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution, Transfer of Property Act, Family Law (Marriage and Succession).

Paper III: - One paper of 100 marks (duration 3 hours) —

1. Civil Procedure Code, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyan-2023(BSA), Garo Hills Autonomous District (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1953.

Personal Interview -(40 marks)

The Candidates who are declared to have passed the screening test/examination shall be called for personal interview. Candidates are required to produce documents in original relating to educational qualifications, date of birth, schedule tribe certificate and others relevant certificates.
